Narcotics Seizure, Wanted Suspects Arrested

Santa Barbara, CA – On Thursday, August 8, 2018, members of the AB109 Compliance Response Team (CRT) developed information that wanted Post-Release Community Supervision (PRCS) offender, 55 year old Samuel Ramirez, was residing at a home on the 300 block of N. La Cumbre Rd. in Santa Barbara. Ramirez had a no bail warrant for his arrest due to absconding from probation.

CRT members established surveillance around the property and Ramirez was seen entering the house. With the assistance of detectives from the Sheriff's Special Investigations Bureau, CRT conducted a probation search at the residence and arrested Ramirez without incident. Several other subjects were contacted inside, including 27-year old Brittany Weiler. Weiler is also on active Santa Barbara County Probation and had a \$25,000 warrant for her arrest for drug charges.

During a probation search of Weiler's property, CRT members located methamphetamine, heroin and numerous hypodermic needles. Weiler was arrested and transported to the Santa Barbara County Jail where she attempted to smuggle in approximately 10.2 grams of heroin.

Weiler was booked for 11350 HS – Possess heroin, 11377 HS – Possess methamphetamine, 11364 HS – Possess drug paraphernalia, 4573 PC – Bring controlled substances into a jail, and her arrest warrant. An 11351 HS [Possess heroin for sale] charge is being submitted to the district attorney's office due to Weiler's attempt to smuggle a large amount of narcotics into the jail.

Samuel Ramirez was booked into Santa Barbara County Jail on his arrest warrant.
